James Hagel, Sacred Circle

Jim is a licensed masters level social worker with over 40 years experience working on Indian issues. His work experience includes community organizer and child development specialist for the Standing Rock Reservation and mental health and field director for the Rosebud and Sisseton-Whapaton Reservations. For 30 years, Jim served as a program planner and psychiatric social worker with Indian Health Services for an in-patient psychiatric unit at the Sioux San Hospital in South Dakota. In addition, he was an adjunct professor for several colleges, served on a number of governor-appointed mental health and health boards, and co-authored several grants and research projects on a variety of Native American issues as well as presenting at local, regional, and national conferences.

Lynne Shull, Nevada Urban Indians

With almost 10 years experience in the field of domestic violence, Lynne currently oversees the Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Program for the Nevada Urban Indians organization located in Reno and Carson City. Her heritage includes a grandfather from the CAAW Tribe originating in Kentucky. In addition to the teachings from her grandfather, Lynne has spent the last few years researching the history, culture, and the ways of "The Good Red Road." Lynne's presentation will discuss two projects stemming from her research currently being offered through Nevada Urban Indians: Batterer's Intervention Training and Parenting, both from a Native American cultural perspective.

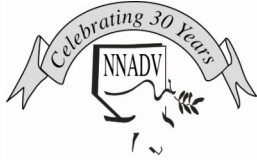
